

Updated Safety Guidelines

In accordance with CDC guidelines, face coverings are no longer required for fully vaccinated persons, indoors or outdoors. While we do not require proof of vaccination, we do expect those who are not fully vaccinated to wear face coverings while indoors. We encourage all participants to keep a safe distance between runners/walkers, and we remain focused on maintaining the highest cleanliness and sanitization standards.

- Participants who are not fully vaccinated are still expected to wear face coverings while indoors
- We encourage all persons to keep a safe distance between others

Please note the CDC advises that **older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions** might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19. Participants should evaluate their risk in determining whether to attend. People who show no symptoms can spread COVID-19 if they are infected, **any interaction with the general public poses an elevated risk of being exposed to COVID-19**, and we cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed during the event.

Face covering guidelines

Face coverings are optional for fully vaccinated guests. Non-vaccinated guests are asked to wear face coverings at all indoor locations.



Wash hands often - Wash your hands with soap and water often for at least 20 seconds.



Social distancing -We encourage all guests to keep a safe distance between your travel party and others.



Avoid contact with people who are sick



Hand sanitizer available - Hand sanitizer will be available for use prior to boarding ride vehicles, as well as in other areas around the destination.
